This policy explains how the LexShield website (lexshield.co.uk) uses cookies and similar technologies, and how you can control them. It is written to meet the UK Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR) and the UK GDPR, and should be read alongside our Privacy Policy.

What cookies and similar technologies are

A cookie is a small text file that a website asks your browser to store on your device. Similar technologies — such as local storage, session storage, pixels and tags — also store information on your device or read information from it. They are used to keep a site working, to remember your choices, to measure how a site is used, or to support advertising.

Why we use them

We use only what is needed for the website to work securely and to remember the cookie choice you make. We do not currently run analytics, advertising, marketing or session recording technologies on this website.

Which are strictly necessary and which require consent

Strictly necessary technologies are exempt from the consent requirement under PECR because the site cannot function or remain secure without them. Everything else — preferences, analytics and marketing — requires your consent before it is used, and is switched off unless you turn it on.

At the date of this policy, no analytics, marketing or preference technologies are installed on this website. The consent controls remain available so that if any are added in future, they will not operate unless you have allowed the relevant category.

Third parties

The only third party involved in delivering this website is Google Ireland Limited, which serves the fonts used for the site's typography. This request does not set cookies or store anything on your device, although Google processes your IP address in order to deliver the font files. Enquiries submitted through our contact form are sent to us by email; that is a server-side process and does not place anything on your device. How we record your choice

Your choice is stored on your own device in local storage under the key `lexshield_cookie_consent`, together with the date and time of your choice and a policy version number. This is a strictly necessary record — we do not use an analytics or marketing cookie to store it. If our cookie use or this policy materially changes, the version number changes and we will ask you again.

Changing or withdrawing your preferences

You can change or withdraw your choice at any time, as easily as you gave it, using the Cookie settings link in the footer of every page. You can also delete cookies and site data through your browser settings.
